

Try it yourself? Another exciting activity from the Dutch *Poppenspe(e)lmuseum* (*Puppetry Museum*). Add a bit of colour to *Jan Klaassen* (the Dutch *Mr Punch*) and the *crocodile*. For example, Jan's hat, his jacket, nose and chin are red. His trousers are usually orange and his clogs are yellow. The Christmas tree is green.

Jan Klaassen is an ordinary lad from Amsterdam, who has a good sense of humour. Those who do him an injustice can count on a scornful remark or a good beating. He is not afraid of anybody. In addition to a fixed set of puppets, the folk puppeteer generally also has a puppet that represents an animal. It is usually a monster with a large mouth that snaps.

Would you like to learn even more about folk and mainstream puppetry figures? In our museum shop we have family board games, postcards, posters and documentation in Dutch, French, German and English, such as *Katrijn* and *Jan Klaassen* and their English cousins Judy and Mr Punch, the German *Kasperl*, the Hungarian *Vitéz László* and the French *Polichinelle*.
