


Simeon the Holy Fool: the patron saint of puppeteers

Simeon was a Christian monk, hermit and saint of the sixth century AD. He is the patron saint of holy fools, puppeteers and ventriloquists. His feast day is 1 July. He is traditionally shown holding a puppet which he used to mock himself and to ridicule the sins and foolishness of others.

A puppeteer is a person who manipulates an inanimate object, such as a puppet, in real time to create the illusion of life.
